WHEN: Spring 2022 **Date TBA**

WHERE: Harrison County Recreation Complex
43 Recreation Drive
on Route 19 south of Clarksburg
(8/10 of a mile past Rosebud Plaza, across from Sunny Croft Golf Course)

WHO: Any child who is at least 4 years old by May 1, 2022
but will NOT have turned 7 by September 1st of this
year.

Registration fee of \$20 **check or money order only**
made payable to: Sheriff & Treasurer of Harrison County

Payment due at time of registration

Parent or guardian must be present to register child.

Child need not be present at time of registration.

HCPR T-BALL Q & A

Q: Will I need to provide Birth Certificate or any other documentation the day of registration?

A: No, the only thing you will need is a check or money order (**NO CASH**) for \$20 payable to Sheriff & Treasurer of Harrison Co.
*Payment is due at the time of registration

Q: Where will games and practices be held?

A: Clinics (teaching players how to throw and other game basics) will be held at North View Elementary.
Practice and Games will be held at Summit Park.

Q: How long do games and practices generally last?

A: Practice and Games are usually around 45 min to an hour in length.

Q: Will I know what team my child will be on the day I register?

A: No, Teams will be selected once registration is completed and announced at clinics.

Q: If my child will be 4 next month can they still register to play this season?

A: As long as your child will be at least 4 by the start of the season (May 1, 2022)
NOT have turned 7 by Sept. 1, 2022, they are eligible to play T-ball this season.

Q: Do you have to be a resident of Clarksburg to register for HCPR T-ball?

A: No, sign ups are open to any resident in Harrison County within the stipulated age group.

Q: Is this program for boys only?

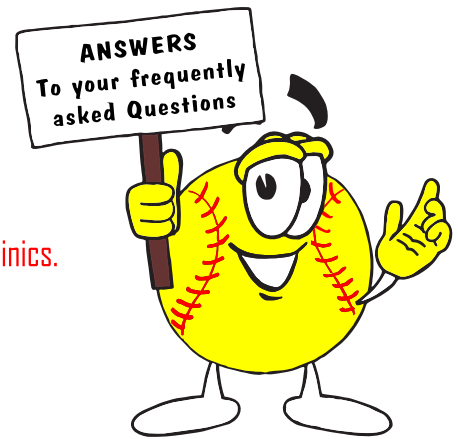
A: No, the program is open to both boys and girls.

Q: Do I need to bring my child to registration?

A: Parent or legal guardian **MUST** be present to register child. Children need not be present.

Q: What dates and times will practice and games be held?

A: There will be 2 practices/games per week weather permitting. Actual dates and times of upcoming practice and games will not be available until registration is completed.
